Lift Up Your 💜 💜 🂜 Art Project

Materials White paper or cardstock © Colored construction paper © Watercolor paints and brush © Drinking straw © Pencil © Scissors © White glue

Directions

1. Using a pencil and the heart pattern, trace a heart in the middle of a sheet of white paper.

2. Use the pattern again to trace four more hearts on different colors of construction paper. Cut out the four hearts and fold each in half lengthwise.

3. Paint along a short section of the heart outline with the watercolors. Quickly use your straw to blow the wet paint toward the outside of the heart outline.

4. Repeat the process using different colors all the way around the heart outline. You will have a pretty, squiggly border around the heart when done. Let it dry.

5. Take one of your construction paper hearts and glue it over the outline on the sheet of paper. (It should be inside the frame you just painted and flat.) Let it dry.

6. Run a line of glue down the fold line (or center) of the heart on the paper. Place the center fold line of one of the folded hearts on the glue and let dry.

7. Repeat with each of the rest of the last two hearts. Let dry, then fluff out for a 3-D effect.
